CONTEST GUIDELINES

How to Participate:

Shoot original, remix or mash-up digital video content to create short animations or videos on the theme “Better Governance through Right To Information”. Your entry should be under five minutes in length and must reach us on a CD/DVD [DVD format - Region 'Zero'] latest by 17:00 Hrs on the 14th of October at the address below.

Digital pictures, sound or films licensed under Creative Commons [search Creative Commons licenses by clicking [here](#)] or in the public domain must be used, and can be combined with your original material if you wish. If you want to learn more about copyright in India, [click here](#).

Theme:

Entries should address the theme “Better Governance Through Right To Information”. You should interpret it creatively and illustratively, remixing historical, contemporary or original material to communicate the theme clearly and imaginatively. A true dramatization of the contest theme is preferred [links and stories on RTI will be regularly updated].

Better Governance Through Right To Information:

The effective use of the Right to Information is really critical for creating better governance models across the length and breadth of our country. The CC movement and the RTI campaign commonly believe that information made available either through disclosure or through liberal copyright licensing is a great public asset. Such ease of access can play a decisive role in creating more transparency, accountability and hopefully more citizen participation in daily governance.

Submitting Your Film:

All entries must ‘Register’ through Avenues and submit a copy of your film on a CD/DVD [Region ‘zero’ format] to Shishir K. Jha. Your movie should be in as high resolution as possible.

Remember: The winning entries will be screened, so we would like the highest quality versions.

Licensing Your Film:

By entering the contest you agree to license your movie as Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-ShareAlike (this license allows derivatives and sharing of content for non-commercial purposes) and to verify that the originals which you have used and transformed are legally available.
