ABOUT THE CONSORTIUM

The Shailesh J. Mehta School of Management (SJMSOM) at IIT Bombay is organizing the second **PhD Consortium** on **October 14 & 15, 2016** at IIT Bombay. The theme for this year's consortium is '**Advances in Theory and Applications in Management Science**'. The objective of the Consortium is to provide doctoral students in management and social sciences an opportunity to present their research and interact with scholars from other institutes, eminent academics, and practitioners whose work involves cutting edge research and management thinking.

FORMAT OF THE CONSORTIUM

The Consortium will include selected paper presentations by doctoral students along with invited talks by leading experts in different domains of management. Doctoral students will receive feedback on their research work and interact with peers as well as distinguished experts. There are plans to have interactive workshops with eminent academics and industry experts for discussions on 'rigour-research gap' that is central to the Consortium's theme.

WHO CAN SUBMIT PAPERS ?

The doctoral consortium is open to any registered PhD/FPM student in an Indian or foreign university/institute. Since we expect a large number of submissions, only papers, which are directly in line with the main themes of the Consortium will be referred by the committee for review. Decision on the submissions will be made on the basis of reviewers' feedback.

PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

We invite full paper submissions from doctoral scholars. The papers should be in Times New Roman 12-point font, single spacing, and APA/AOM referencing style. The paper should be maximum 15 pages long (all inclusive, with one inch margin on all sides) and include personal particulars like name, title of paper, affiliation (Department and Institute), e-mail, telephone and postal address. It should also include an abstract of maximum 300 words.

INVITED DISTINGUISHED SPEAKERS

The invitees include distinguished academics and industry experts. They will speak at the event, conduct workshops, and interact with the participants.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND REGISTRATION FEE

Economy class return airfare (Air India only) from place of work/institute in India will be reimbursed as per IIT Bombay rules. Overseas presenters are requested to arrange for their international travel as only domestic travel in economy class by Air India shall be reimbursed. Lodging (maximum three nights, beginning 13/10/2016) and boarding for the paper presenters will also be provided. Local conveyance will be reimbursed upon submission of valid receipts as per rules. There will be a nominal registration fee of Rs.500 for paper presenters.
