



# Option I : HOW TO INSTALL SOM LIBRARY NETWORK PRINTER


1) Click **Yes**




2) Select **Standard & Next**




3) Click **Next**




4) Select **Printer from List** & **Next**



5) Select **Printer from List & Next**




6) **Exit & Restart your computer or Laptop**




# Option II : HOW TO INSTALL SOM LIBRARY NETWORK PRINTER


1) Click **Yes**




2) Select **Custom** & **Next**

4) Select **Printer (iR-ADV 4525) from List & Next**




5) Click **Add Port**
